Curriculum Overview

Book Focus:

This half term we are reading as class the Shakespeare play 'Macbeth'.

This could be: Sir Winston Churchill, Walter Tull, Adolf Hitler, Edith Cavell or an individual of your own choice. You will need to research your chosen person and then choose how you wish to present your information. You could do this as a Powerpoint Presentation; a fact file poster — either on the computer or created by hand; you could create an interactive poster — with flaps to lift which reveal the answer to questions. Be as creative as you like!

We would like your fact file to be handed in (either physically or by email) by Monday 12th February 2023. We will then create a wonderful display of all of your amazing fact files. We can't wait to see them!
