
# St Mary's Church of England Junior Academy

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## Year 5 Trip to West Stow

On Wednesday, 13th December, year five had a fantastic day at West Stow in Suffolk, expanding their knowledge on the Anglo Saxons. We explored a variety of reconstructed dwellings that created an Anglo-Saxon 'village', saw a carpenter at work and a roof being thatched. The children asked these craftsmen many questions and received detailed answers. We also had an exploratory session on different replica artefacts and had to examine and explore what these were and what they were used for. Finally, we visited the museum and learnt more about the history of the Anglo Saxons and viewed many finds and treasures that archaeologists had uncovered. We even had the chance to dress up in a variety of clothes and the particular favourite - the Anglo Saxon Helmet. A wonderful, educational day enjoyed by all - children and adults alike which truly embedded the children's historic knowledge.


























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## Choir singing at Mayfields Care Home
