



A typical school day at St Mary's

Adjusted for Covid 19

8:30 8:30 – 8:50	The school gates are opened – children along with their parents/carers are welcomed into the school grounds and onto the playground where they will be met by class teachers. This is a good opportunity to talk to teachers before the day starts. <i>The school gates are opened – following the times below, children go straight to their classroom where they are met and greeted by their teachers.</i> <i>8:30 – 8:40 for Years 4 and 6</i> <i>8:40 – 8:50 for Years 3 and 5</i>
8:37	The children line up alphabetically in their class lines and the teachers lead them to their classes.
8:45 8:30 – 8:50	Children arrive in their classes where they set themselves up for the day. They hang their coats on their pegs and put their lunches and water bottles in their correct locations. <i>Children arrive in their classes where they set themselves up for the day. They hang their coats on their chairs and put their lunches and water bottles in their trays.</i> <i>8:30 – 8:40 for Years 4 and 6</i> <i>8:40 – 8:50 for Years 3 and 5</i>
8:50 8:30 – 8:50	The children start work on their spellings and handwriting activities while the teacher takes the attendance and dinner register. They can order a hot or cold option from the school kitchen.
9:10	The classes all go to the hall for the daily Collective Worship. <i>The classes have the daily Collective Worship in their classrooms through virtual assemblies or teacher-led classroom assemblies.</i>
9:30	English – back in classes the children work on English following the Talk 4 Writing and Read, Write Inc programs. <i>Read, Write Inc takes place in bubbles.</i>
10:30 10:10 – 10:45	Morning Break – children can take a snack outside and enjoy the fresh air with their friends. <i>10:10-10:25 (Year 3 &5)</i> <i>10:30-10:45 (Year 4 &6)</i>
10:45 10:25 – 11:00	Maths – back in class again for a Power Maths session. This always includes a mental starter to get the brains engaged.
11:55 11:50 – 1:10	Lunch time – Children can bring in their own packed lunch or have their pre-ordered school option. The lunch hour is spent in the hall and outside on the playground or field. <i>Lunch time rotas ensure that children remain in bubbles.</i> <i>11:50-12:50 (Year 3 &4)</i> <i>12:10-1:10 (Year 5 &6)</i>
12:55 12:50/1:10	The teachers collect the children for the afternoon session, take the register and read some of the class reading book.
1:15 1:10/1:30	Topic – depending on the class time table, the children take part in one of these curriculum areas.
3:15 3:00/ 3:10	The teacher takes the children on to the playground for the end of day dismissal. The classes line up on the playground ready for parents/cares to collect. Another good opportunity for teachers to talk to parents/carers if needed. <i>The teachers take the children to the front gate for the end of day dismissal.</i> <i>3:00 (Year 4&6)</i> <i>3:10 (Year 3&5)</i>
