Curriculum Overview

Book Focus:

This half term we are reading as a class *The Song from Somewhere Else* by A. F. Harrold and Levi Pinfold.

English:

In English we are learning to write discussions, alternative story endings and poetry based on Seasons of Splendour by Madhur Jaffrey. We will also be covering SPaG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and hand writing throughout our English lessons. Our reading skill development will be based around our science and topic texts along with vocabularly development.
