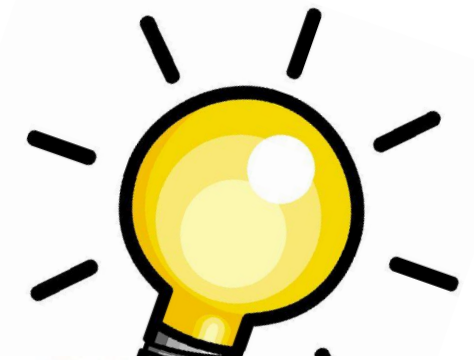
Reading:

a) Read it PROPERLY and THOROUGHLY for understanding!

b) Did I understand it?

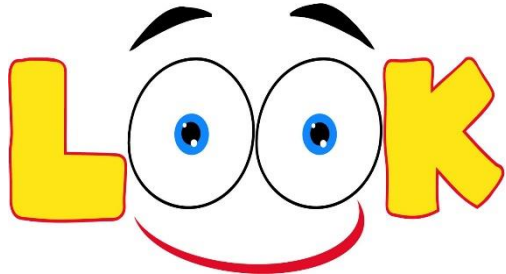
(i) Yes = Read on.

(ii) No = Re-read the paragraph.

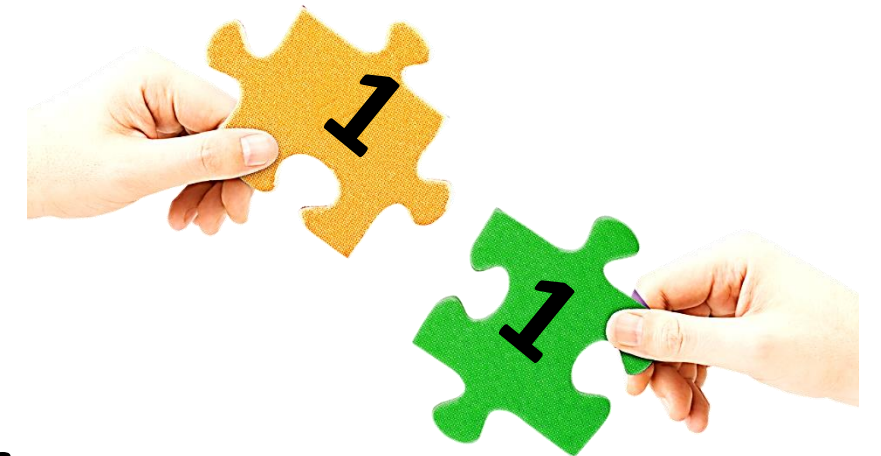


Questions:



a) Underline the key words from the question which tell me what to do or what to  for.

b) Underline the MATCHING EVIDENCE on the text paper (I can write the question number too, to help me find it later when I'm checking my answers).





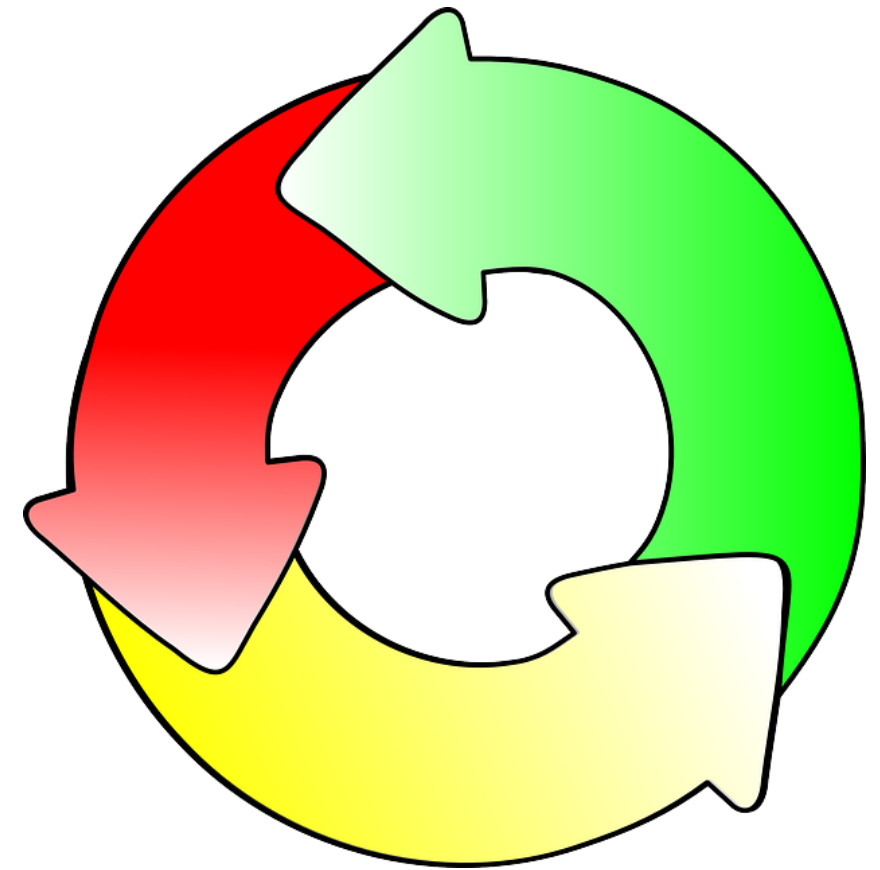
c) Use the words from the text in my answers – even if I need to give an impression or explain.

d) **NO BLANK ANSWERS!** Skip questions I am unsure of or which are taking me a long time to answer BUT... make sure to come back to answer them at the end. If I'm short on time, make an educated guess and tick it.



Checking my answers:

- a) Re-read the question.
- b) Refer to the evidence in the text which I underlined AND the text just before and after underlines.
- c) Re-read my answer.
