Curriculum Overview

Book Focus:

This half term we are reading 'One Plastic Bag', written by Miranda Paul.

English:

In English we are learning to develop skills and knowledge in how to write instructions, explanation texts, diary entries (recount) and Haiku poetry.

Maths:

In Maths we will be learning about: length & perimeter of polygons; fractions of shapes and amounts and decimal equivalents.

Science:

Our science topic this half term is Light and Shadows.

We are focusing on European countries, looking at key physical and humans features of European countries, and taking a more in-depth look at Italy.
