Curriculum Overview

Book Focus:

This half term we are reading The Boy at the back of the Class.

English:

In English we are returning to stories from other cultures and will be writing imaginative diary entries.

Maths:

In Maths we will be focussing on decimals and starting money.

Science:

Our science topic this half term is sound.

Topic:

History

This half term we will be investigating the Maya civilisation.

Art/DT:

We will be looking at fastenings in textiles.

Music:

We will be studying how to use music to learn about expression and improvisation.

PE:

We will be practising dodgeball and athletics this half term.

PSHE:

We will be looking at citizenship and what being a good citizen means.

RE:

Our key question this half term is what does sacrifice mean?

Computing:

We will be learning about online safety and learning about algorithms.

Your child will need to bring the correct PE kit to school on a **Wednesday.** PE will be outside unless the weather is exceptionally cold, or it is raining.

Homework

Each week, your child will receive:

- Times tables
- A reading book

These need to be practised daily.

In addition to this, there will be a half termly homework set on Class Dojo. This will be related to our science/history unit.

Reminders:

- Reading books need to be brought into school every day as we will be using them at 8.40 for individual readers
- As the weather is now warming up, please ensure that your child has on sunscreen and a sunhat with them on hot days.
- Please make sure your child has a water bottle with them every day containing only water.
