Curriculum Overview

Book Focus:

This half term we are reading The Queen's Nose as a class.

English:

In English we are learning to write a persuasive piece of writing, and writing poems that explore form.

Maths:

In Maths we will be learning place value, as well as addition and subtraction.

Science:

Our science topic this half term is teeth and digestion.

Topic:

History -

We are focusing on the Roman invasion of Britain.

Art/DT:

We will be drawing power prints.

Music:

We will be learning about musical structures.

PE:

We will be practising handball and football this half term.

PSHE:

We will be discussing families and relationships.

RE:

Our key question is how do religious groups contribute to society and culture?

Computing:

We will be learning about online safety and computer systems and networks.

PE/Forest school

Year 4 PE and forest school will be on **Wednesday**.

Year 4 will alternate each week between PE and using the forest school area. PE will be outside when weather permits, and forest school will be outside most of the time, so please ensure that your child has suitable clothes and footwear.

Homework

Each week, we would like children to read at home and record their reading in their reading record. We would also like them to practice on Times Tables Rockstars as well.

In addition to this, there will be a half termly homework set on Class Dojo. This will be related to our science/history unit.

Reminders:

- Reading books need to be brought into school **every day** as we will be using them at 8.40 for individual readers
- As the weather is starting to get colder, your child will need to bring a **waterproof coat** with them to school each day.
